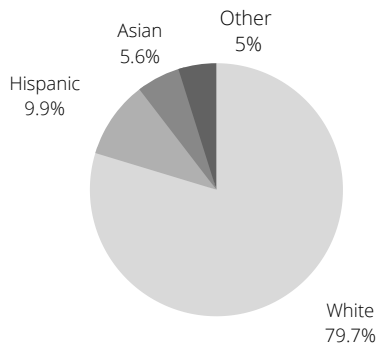

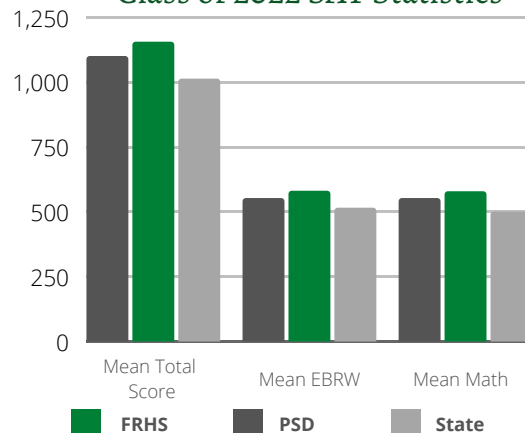

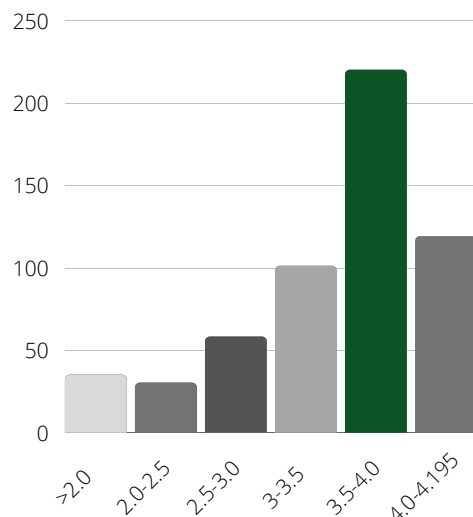

Class of 2022 SAT Statistics



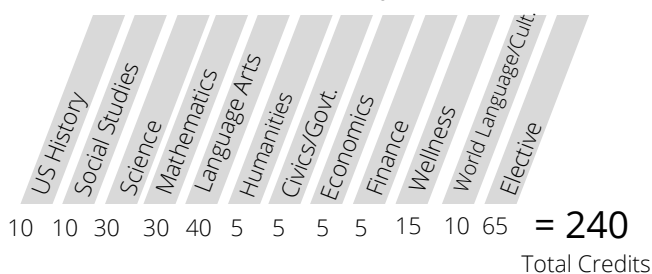
Adjusted Cumulative GPA - Class of 2022
