Fossil Ridge uses a 2-semester, 7-period schedule, with alternating blocks.

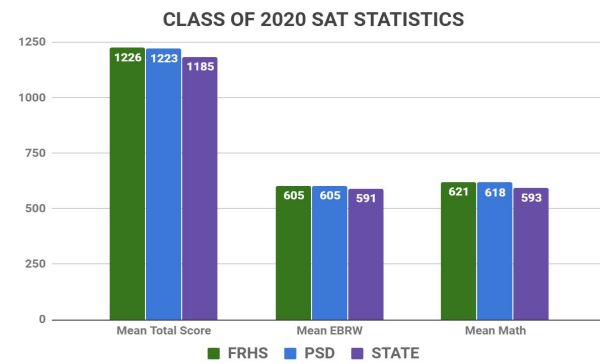
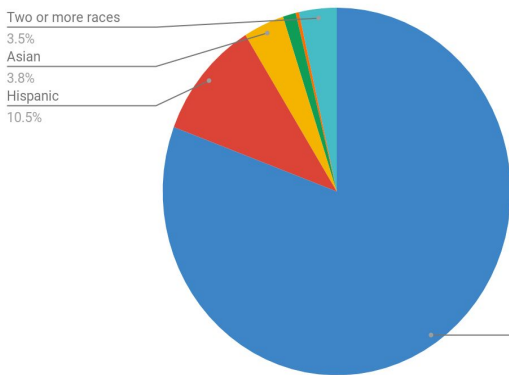
A full schedule awards 70 credits, plus an additional 2 credits for advisory class, which is a course for college and career planning and is required for all students.

***20-21 School Year** Fossil will be using a quarter system where students will complete their odd classes during quarters 1 & 3 and their even classes during quarters 2 & 4

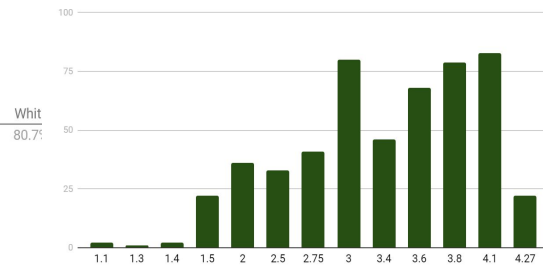

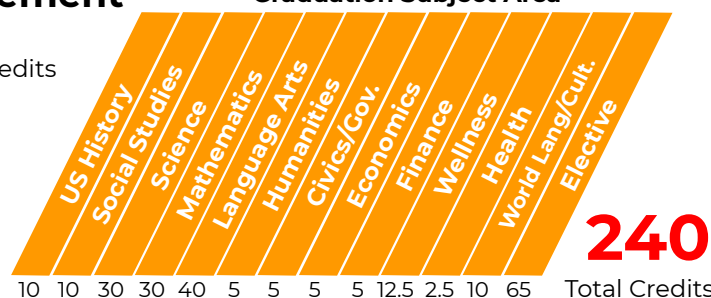

In Poudre School District, students must successfully complete a minimum of 240 credits by the end of 12th grade.

Ten credits are equivalent to one full year of study in a specific subject. Five credits is a semester long course.
