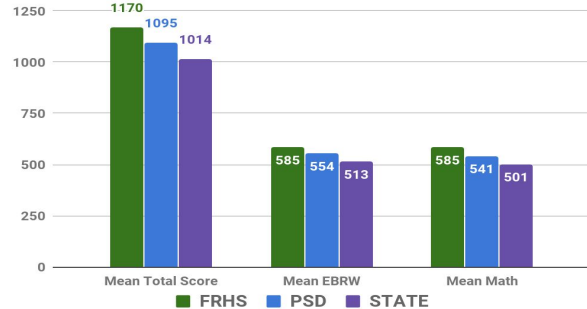
Fossil Ridge High School (FRHS) is located in Fort Collins, Colorado and part of the Poudre School District. Fort Collins has a population of approximately 165,000 residents, is home to Colorado State University, a thriving tech sector, and is ranked as one of the best places to live in the US.

Fossil Ridge uses a 2-semester, 7-period schedule, with alternating blocks. A full schedule awards 70 credits, plus an additional 2 credits for advisory class, which is a course for college and career planning and is required for all students.

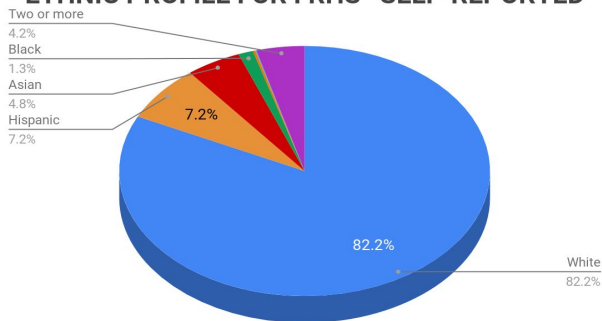

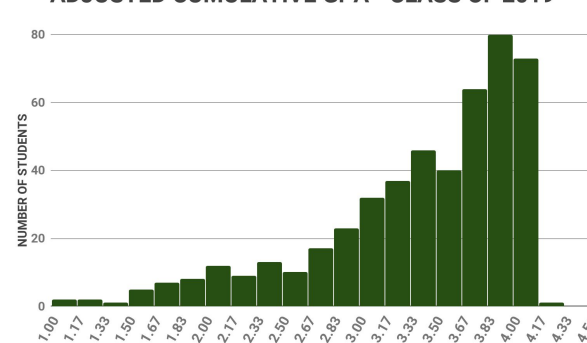
CLASS OF 2019 SAT STATISTICS

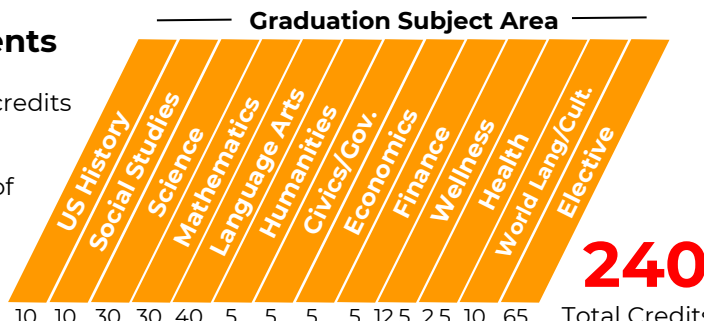

District Graduation Requirements

In Poudre School District, students must successfully complete a minimum of 240 credits by the end of 12th grade.

Ten credits are equivalent to one full year of study in a specific subject. Five credits is a semester long course.
